You are invited to apply for a 10-week internship on the *Earth Girl: Earth Mission* 2D anime-style animation project, written and directed by Liz Courtney from EOS with consultation from senior faculty from ADM. Liz Courtney is Artist in Residence at The Earth Observatory of Singapore, a film director and environmentalist, with awardwinning projects such as Youth4Planet, Cool School Antarctica and The Tipping Points (IMDB).

We are setting up a team of five 2D animators who have an interest in anime style animation. There will be two senior animation supervisors, one director, and consultation from two ADM Professors.

Internship job scope and responsibilities description:

The animation team will be responsible for adapting the existing Earth Girl character into a more distinct anime style, and creating 3 short, animated movies. The team will need to have proficient anime-style drawing and animation skills. An appreciation for climate change solutions will help.

All work will follow direction from the director who will lead the narrative direction. Production will be overseen by animation production supervisors. Technical assistance and guidance will be provided.

The final movies will be distributed and shown across the Asian region, and available internationally.

Pre-requisite from candidate (if any):

Any combination of these abilities will be considered:

- Script development and beat sheet drawing.
- Storyboarding
- Colouring scripting
- Character re-designing and original designs of new characters in style
- Proficient ability in any 2D software, e.g. TV Paint, Toon Boom, Rough Animator etc)
- Background and props painting
- Compositing e.g. After Effects, Premiere or Nuke
- Rendering (Premiere)
- Production coordination of a small team
