### knitting

- Knitting is a method by which thread or yarn is used to create a cloth.
- Knitted fabric consists of a number of consecutive rows of loops, called stitches. As each
  row progresses, a new loop is pulled through an existing loop. The active stitches are
  held on a <u>needle</u> until another loop can be passed through them. This process eventually
  results in a fabric, often used for garments.
- Knitting may be done by hand or by <u>machine</u>. There exist numerous styles and methods of hand knitting.
- Different types of yarns and needles may be used to achieve a plethora of knitted materials; these tools give the final piece a different colour, texture, weight, and/or integrity. Other factors that affect the end result include the needle's shape, thickness and malleability, as well as the yarn's fibre type, texture and twist.


