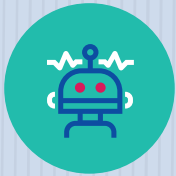


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CODE IN THE COMMUNITY

Classes will be held...

Twice a week over 4 weeks this November. All classes will be conducted over Zoom.

As a volunteer...

You will need to commit to 4 teaching hours per week for 4 consecutive weeks.

You will also need to commit to a mandatory check-in session and 6-8 hours of independent e-learning with materials from Saturday Kids prior to the start of the first lesson.

As the quality of instruction and consistency for kids is our utmost priority (as it should be!), we ask for your full commitment to these trainings.

Instructors will be provided with a stipend of \$20/teaching hour.

You should volunteer if...

You love working with kids and would like to gain more experience teaching in an (online) classroom!

Most of our Scratch instructors from non-technical backgrounds pick up the introductory block-based language within a few hours (it's designed for kids after all!).

All volunteers are required submit a basic coding project as part of the application.
