

Themed "Building a strong, united Singapore", the <u>Singapore Budget 2019</u> was delivered by Finance Minister, Mr Heng Swee Keat on 18 February.

The bulk of Budget 2019 is aimed at helping lower-income Singaporeans cope with the increased cost of living, and honouring the <u>Merdeka Generation</u>. A \$200 million Bicentennial Community Fund was also launched, which will match donations to <u>Institutions of a Public Character</u> (IPCs) dollar for dollar.

In addition, Budget 2019 covers the long-term investment in protecting Singapore from the effects of global warming, and this includes implementing a carbon tax and a Zero Waste Masterplan.


