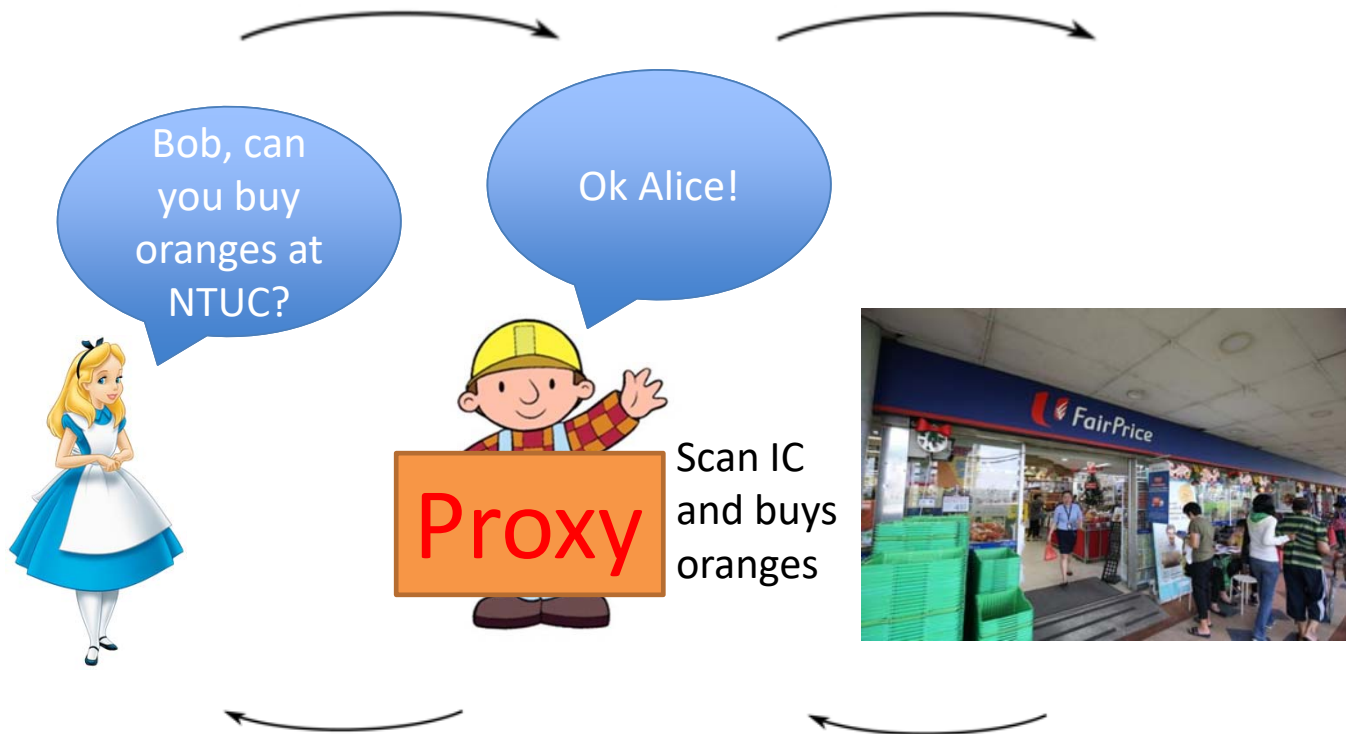

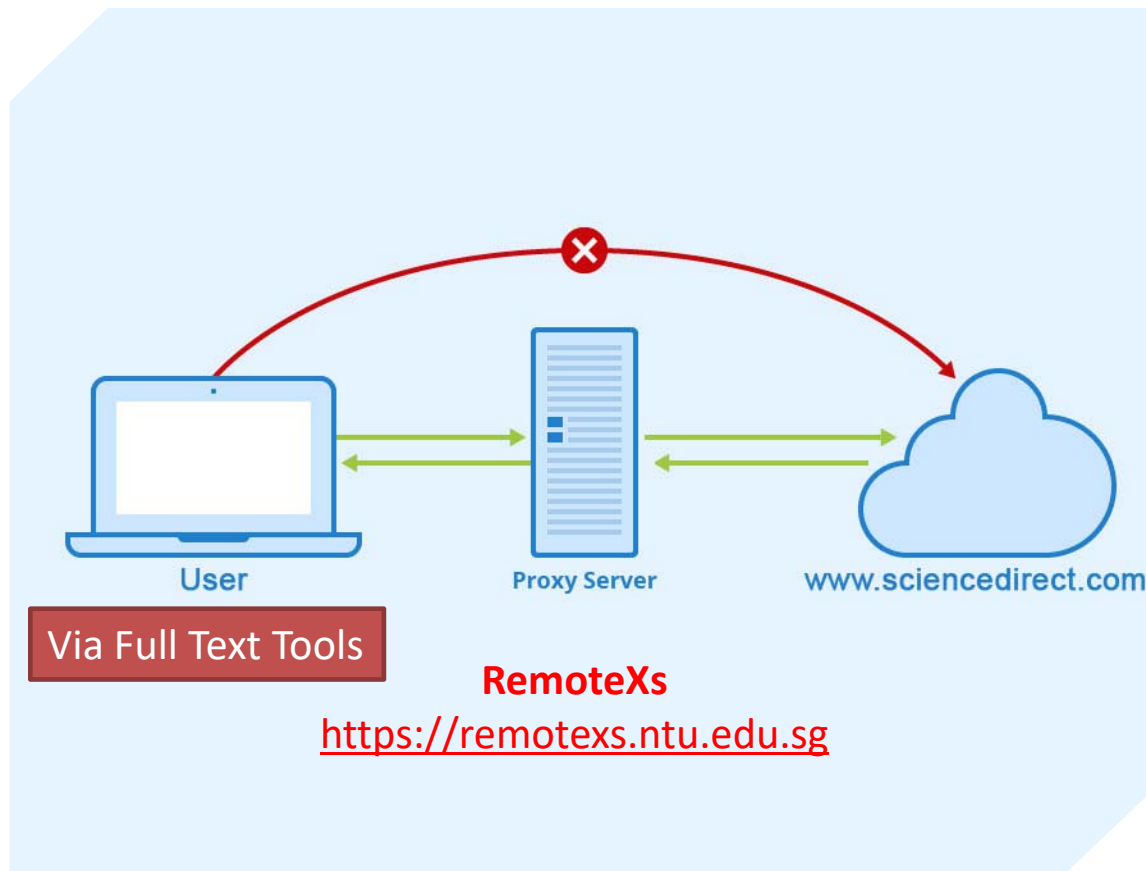

- Users connect to the proxy via Full Text Tools (NTU LibBookmark or NTU LibGenie) or proxied links



NTU LibGenie
(for desktop browser)

A smart extension for your desktop browser to provide seamless access to subscribed full text e-resources and assist automatically with alternatives when you hit barriers.

NTU LibBookmark
(for desktop/mobile browser)

A simple bookmark for your mobile/desktop browser to enable easy access to subscribed full text e-resources.

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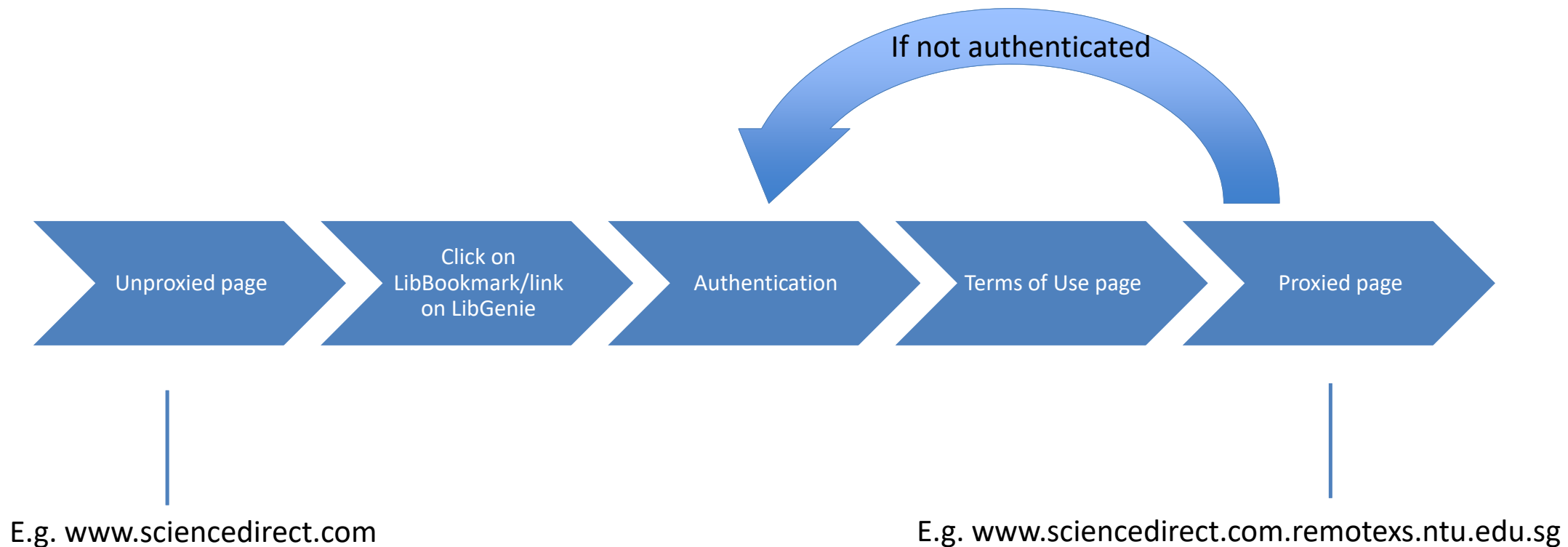

Need access to full text e-resources anytime, anywhere? Looking to see if you are subscribed by NTU Library? Found a useful article online or e-book but with access barriers and wondering if there are alternative routes or open access options?

NTU Library has the tools you need to unlock your access to full text e-resources.

There are 2 tools to access full text e-resources subscribed by NTU Library: LibGenie for Staff/Students and Associate Staff the most since they would have full access.

- **NTU LibGenie** - A smart extension for your desktop browser to provide access to subscribed full text e-resources and assist automatically with alternative routes.
- **NTU LibBookmark** - A simple bookmark for your mobile/desktop browser to access subscribed full text e-resources by NTU Library.

Further Notes on NTU LibGenie

- Colors
 - Green: Library Access and Alternatives
 - Orange: Library Assist
 - Grey: Shown when there's no results
- Mobile users will still need the bookmark.
- Assist messages work in the following way:
 - Library Assist messages has a countdown of 10 seconds: Once the countdown ends, it won't show the popup again (this is to avoid end-users seeing the same popup over and over again)
 - If you disable / enable the extension or just simply relaunch your browser, the assist message will be shown again.
- LibGenie does not collect user data.
- When accessing Google Scholar, user does not need to set NTU as one of the Library links. Lean Library will automatically set it as NTU and provide Full Text Links by searching the library holdings.

Difference between LibBookmark and LibGenie

| | LibBookmark | LibGenie |
|---|--|---|
| 1 | Need to click on bookmark on browser toolbar to activate | Pop-up box appears upon activation (Color will be green or orange) |
| 2 | No guidance | Pop-up to guide you or give you alternatives to the full text resource |
| 3 | Recommended if you prefer to manually click to check for full text | Not recommended if you do not like pop-ups constantly appearing on your screen (unless you select "Skip the popup and automate access") |
| 4 | Works on desktop and mobile browsers | Works on desktop browsers |
